

RULES

1. STARTING TIME

The pre-race briefing starts at 2:40 PM (EST) and the race starts at 3:00 PM at the Community Building 401 N Boundary Street. Check-in opens at 1:30 PM. Teams are strongly encouraged to arrive no later than 2:30 PM.

2. TEAM SIZE

Teams may range from two to four people. Children not participating in the race may not accompany a race team.

3. RACE BIBS

Race bibs must be worn at all times by participants. Your race bib (provided at check-in) is your ticket to participate in each challenge station and identifies you to race staff and hosting challenge sites. Without a race bib participants will be denied entry into challenge areas and race activities.

4. RACE ACTIVITIES

All race activities are optional. The race consists of challenge stations and puzzles. There is no penalty for not completing any of the race activities.

5. POINTS & SCORING

Points are earned based on the number of challenges completed and puzzles solved correctly. The team with the most points at the conclusion of the race wins. The total amount of time it takes each team to complete the race is recorded, and in the event of a tied score, the team with the fastest time is declared the winner.

6. TRANSPORTATION

Teams must travel on foot in the playing area to be eligible for prizes. If a team drives, bikes, or takes public transportation during the race they will not be eligible to win prizes.

7. SMARTPHONE USE

Participants may use smartphones during the event.

8. FINISH LINE

The race ends at 6:00 PM. All race materials must be turned in before 6:00 PM to be considered part of the team's score. For example, if a team turns in their materials at 6:01PM, they will not be eligible for any prizes.
